Be respectful

Please be respectful to other learners' opinions and comments. Be polite when posting your own comments. Some course topics can create controversy and debate, but we all have to respect the opinions of other people.

Review the messages before posting a new one

Before posting a new comment or question to the discussion forum, please check if any other learner has already posted a message about the same issue. You can pin those questions similar to yours or that you consider interesting, instead of creating a new conversation. It is a way to keep the teachers focused on those topics and questions of a higher interest.

Use the discussion forum just for issues related to the course

Even though we encourage learners to introduce themselves and get to know each other, please use the discussion forum just for conversations about the course content, and not for any personal messages or debates on any other topic.

Report any technical problem as soon as possible
